**Dr. Kurt W. Liedtke** was elected Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Robert Bosch Stiftung GmbH on October 1, 2007. Starting as an in-house lawyer at Bosch in 1977, Dr Liedtke went on to hold positions in Spain during the 1980's, including Managing Director of Robert Bosch Comercial Española S.A. in Madrid. In 1989, he became Managing Director of Robert Bosch Limited, United Kingdom and from 1996 to 2000, served as Chairman and Managing Director of Robert Bosch Australia. From 2001, he was Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Robert Bosch Corporation in the USA, and became Member of the Board of Management of Robert Bosch GmbH in 2002. Retiring at the end of 2005, he has since become chair of the Board of Trustees.

**David Robinson** held a variety of managerial positions at Federal Mogul prior to joining Bosch in 1990. With Bosch, David has served primarily in North America but also in Germany as President of Bosch Automotive Motor Systems, Executive Vice President of Heavy-Duty Sales, Executive Vice President of Diesel Fuel Injection Technology and as President of Automotive Body Electrical and Electronic Products. In May 2007, David joined Robert Bosch (Australia) Pty. Ltd. as President.

Robert Bosch (Australia) Pty. Ltd. is a regional subsidiary of the global Bosch Group, one of the world's largest private industrial corporations. The global Bosch Group employs some 280,000 people worldwide and achieved a sales revenue of EUR 45.1 billion in 2008 (approx AUD 74 billion).
